

New Mexico raised its tax on oil production in 2010 to pay for repairs at a brine well in Carlsbad, N.M., but the money has largely gone to other priorities. Here's a breakdown of revenue and spending from New Mexico's reclamation fund from fiscal 2010 to 2016, the last full year available.
