Hi Tate,

Just a couple of updates. Atlantic Richfield/BP is willing and able to have the whole Anaconda tour and signing on the mine site, behind the locked gate. We'll work on details on how to keep the "official" party separate from the ceremony invitees for touring purposes. Will you please look at the EPA list of attendees and (1) add titles for situational awareness; (2) identify who needs to be in a car with the Administrator at Anaconda; and (3) who on your list should be on the tour in a different vehicle. I think we'll be ok with all, but ARC needs to know for vehicle purposes. Also, if you would forward this information to those on your team that need it, I'd appreciate it. I'm not sure and don't want to leave anyone out.

For the Cocur visit, they will have between 75 and 100 employees gathered after the tour to hear remarks and meet the Governor and Administrator. I told them we'd love as many as they can spare (they won't be shutting down operations). All attendees will go on the tour. There will be a 14 passenger van for the principals. The mine manager and Coeur's VP for Environment will be in that van with the Administrator and Governor. We will also have our state expert in that van. Who from your team should be in that van as well? All other attendees, including press, will be in a large bus that will follow the smaller van. When we leave the Rochester mine, they will provide box lunches for everyone since we don't have time for a lunch built into the schedule.

I've attached an updated timeline and list of attendees for each event. These are still draft and may change, but I'll keep you posted. Because both events are behind security gates, we'll be pretty strict

about following the list. We'll have extra staff there with the lists to check off names. Do you know when your advance/security team will make a site visit? I'm not adding security information -- I'm letting the respective details work that out with the on-site security.

A couple of things to remind your team:

- Casual dress - jeans/khakis, no ties, the Governor may have a blazer
- Long pants - no shorts or skirts
- Closed toe, sturdy shoes,
- Light jacket - the weather is supposed to be good, but you never know

I've probably missed things. If so, I'll keep forwarding information.
