I am pleased to announce that effective today, Mary Walker will serve as the Acting Regional Administrator for EPA's Region 4 office. Mary has been the Region 4 Deputy Regional Administrator since June 2018, and prior to that she was the regional Water Protection Division Director. In these roles, she worked tirelessly to improve coordination with our states in the southeast region, as well as the timeliness of EPA actions.

Before joining EPA, Mary was the Assistant Director and Chief Operating Officer for the Georgia Environmental Protection Division, where she oversaw policy development and rulemaking for all media, permitting and compliance programs, and general agency operations. She is a graduate of the Institute for Georgia Environmental Leaders, served on the EPA/State E-Enterprise for the Environment Leadership Council, and represented EPA on the Southern States Energy Board.
