Our office is investigating a workplace fatality involving a crude oil truck driver that was found dead at a tank battery location Saturday. He had been up on the crude oil tank, opened the thief hatch and took a sample. He was found at ground level next to his truck and had begun filling the transport truck.

We have investigated a cluster of these type events around the country and one in Love County in OK a couple years ago where employees pass away after opening the thief hatch. This event (as with others similar) does not alarm the worker's H2S monitor they are wearing and OSHA has studied the issue of high VOC levels with possible oxygen deficient plumes above the thief hatch. I am attaching a presentation that describes some of the study that OSHA has been conducting surrounding these events. Feel free to call me if you want to discuss this. **Exemption 5**
