Direction of Interest Query

February 21, 2017

On February 21, 2017, the Environmental Protection Agency requested a search of the U.S. Secret Service's protective intelligence database for subjects of record with the U.S. Secret Service who have expressed an inappropriate or threatening direction of interest in Administrator Scott Pruitt. The information provided below is based on a review of the Secret Service's protective intelligence records. These records are limited by the scope of the Secret Service's protective mission and only include those individuals whose interest in the aforementioned coincided with risk-related behavior directed toward a protectee of this Service. No attempt was made to evaluate the level of danger the subject posed, or currently may pose, to Administrator Pruitt. This response to the EPA's request for information should not be interpreted as or considered to be a threat assessment.

The Protective Intelligence and Assessment Division has not received any reports of behaviors of interest directed toward EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt.

The Protective Intelligence and Assessment Division has received one report of an individual with a behavior of interest in the EPA in the past six months and is described below:
