As perhaps she reported, executives from Dominion and I had a very productive meeting with her and acting Deputy Secretary Jim Cason yesterday to try to sort through some regulatory issues at Interior that are slowing the permitting of the Atlantic Coast Pipeline Project (ACP). ACP is a \$5-plus billion pipeline that will create thousands of jobs and transport over 1.5 Bcf gas/day and is considered a major infrastructure initiative by the Trump Administration. We've got some headaches at USDA as well. Is there a chance you might be available for a meeting next week to talk through some of the challenges we're facing?
